FACULTY OF MEDICINE AND BIOMEDICAL SCIENCES

In this Faculty, we train medical doctors, nurses and nutritionists at the undergraduate level, while midwives are trained at the postgraduate level (MSc Reproductive Health). Our focus is to train the manpower our country needs to achieve its dream of providing health to everyone. We emphasise on community-based training, with high ethical and moral values.

FACULTY OF SCIENCE, ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY

All degree programmes are professionalised to a large extent. In Chemistry, for instance, effort is made to provide the student with skills in analytical work (forensic considerations, quality control, etc), while programmes such as Animal Production, Food Technology, Mining and Extractive Metallurgy and Petroleum Engineering, are professional by their very nature. The current efforts by the government to modernise agriculture implies that there will be a great need of trained manpower in Food Technology to transform the expected production into marketable products.

We take a lot of interest in the Mining and Petroleum Engineering because these are two new areas which train people for jobs in Cameroon and in the Central African Sub-Region where mineral and petroleum exploration is expanding phenomenally.

FACULTY OF ARTS, SOCIAL AND MANAGEMENT SCIENCES

We recognise the rate at which publishing, theatre, television and especially the cinematographic industry are growing in the world, but which has been lagging in Cameroon. We intend to contribute in a significant way to close the yawning gap by offering a series of degrees that address these concerns. Performing Arts and Cinematography, English Language and Publishing constitute our trump card. The bilingual degree we are offering has an important one-year immersion in a typical professional milieu, aimed at making the graduate immediately marketable. Publishing will be combined with either English or French.

Other degree courses offered in Accountancy, Marketing, Banking and Finance, Management and Economics, are known for their professional orientation.

FACULTY OF PHILOSOPHY, RELIGIOUS AND SOCIAL STUDIES

We are consistent with our global focus - that of training our students holistically. Morals, ethics and the fear of the Lord remain the guiding principles of the University. In this regard we open our doors to those who want to know the Bible more deeply, by offering a full degree in Religious Studies, and another in Philosophy. We are introducing a degree in Clinical Counseling (MSc) aimed at training people who can take care of persons afflicted by disease, with a sense of feeling. This is compelling in our medical set up. We also offer postgraduate degrees in Social Work, Development Studies, Business Entrepreneurship and in Educational Planning and Policy Analysis.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The requirements presented here below are the minimum for admission into any study programme in the Cameroon Christian University.

1. The General Certificate of Education Ordinary Level with pass grades in at least five (05) approved subjects including English Language.
2. The General Certificate of Education Advanced Level:

- ◆ Two subjects at the same sitting
 - ◆ The Baccalaureate (BACC) in a series appropriate to the field of studies chosen.
 - ◆ Any other qualification considered by the University as equivalent.
3. Individual Faculties/Departments may impose additional entry requirements. (See below)

Those whose language of instruction was not English will be required to pass a prescribed English Language Proficiency Test, unless they have successfully undertaken the special intensive English Language course, organised by the University at Bali, between July and September every year.

SPECIFIC DEGREE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

FACULTY OF MEDICINE AND BIOMEDICAL SCIENCES

In addition to the minimum University entry requirements, candidates for the Faculty of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences must have Mathematics at the GCE Ordinary Level and pass grades in at least two (02) science subjects (one must be biology) at the GCE Advanced Level. In addition, candidates must write and pass a competitive entrance examination organised by the University.

FACULTY OF SCIENCE, ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY

In addition to the University entry requirements, candidates for the Faculty of Science, Engineering and Technology must have pass grades in Mathematics and Physics at the GCE Ordinary Level and pass grades in at least two (02) science subjects at the GCE Advanced Level to qualify for enrolment into Animal Science and Food Technology degree programmes; for Chemistry, candidates must have at least a pass grade in Chemistry at the Advanced Level.

In order to be considered for admission into Chemical Engineering, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Machinery Tooling and Maintenance, Industrial Chemistry, Veterinary Medicine, Mining and Extractive Metallurgy and Petroleum Engineering programmes, candidates must have pass grades in Mathematics, Physics and/or Chemistry. In addition, candidates must write and pass the competitive entrance examination organised by the University. Foreign students are admitted on the basis of a rigorous screening of their application files.

FACULTY OF ARTS, SOCIAL AND MANAGEMENT SCIENCES

In addition to the University requirements, candidates for Accountancy, Banking and Finance, Economics, Marketing and Management, must have a pass grade in Ordinary Level Mathematics. A pass in Advanced Level Economics will be an additional Advantage. Holders of the RSA and LCCI stage III with passes in five (05) approved subjects including English and at least two (02) subjects including Economics shall be considered.

NB: Subjects such as Typing, Secretarial Studies and Office Routine etc, will not be considered.

Performing Arts and Cinematography, English Language and Publishing: candidates must have pass grades in at least two (02) Advanced Level subjects including a pass grade in English Literature. Candidates for the Bilingual degree must have pass grades in English Literature and French.

FACULTY OF PHILOSOPHY, RELIGIOUS AND SOCIAL STUDIES

In addition to the general University Requirements, candidates must have a pass grade in English Literature, Philosophy and/or Religion. Candidates for Clinical Counselling and Social Work must be holders of the first degree.
